<b>11. ENTRANT'S LICENCES:</b>		
Where the entrant is NOT the rider, an entrant's licence must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the regional programme.		
<b>12. ENTRY TO CIRCUIT:</b>		
Entrance to the grounds will be free for a (1) rider and a (1) mechanic – The mechanic must accompany the rider and the machine.		
As decided on by the organising club, all other persons will have to pay an entry fee in the amount of	<b>Adults – R50.00</b> <b>Children – 15 years under R 20</b> <b>Children – 6 and under - free</b>	
<b>13. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING:</b>

<b>Riders late for documentation will be charged an additional R200.00</b>		
Self Scrutineering will apply. Forms will be attached to the regs, and must be returned completed when lining up for practice. Should more than one bike be utilised, kindly ensure that it is included on the self scrutineering form as it is 1 form per bike. This is to be done by the start of practice. Refer to SSR 226 in the 2019 MSA National Motocross Regulations.		
<b>14. RIDERS BRIEFING:</b>		
Refer to race programme in point 34.		
All riders must be present at the briefing at the stipulated time and venue. Representatives may accompany the rider to the briefing, but may not represent the rider. Failure to attend the riders briefing may result in a fine of R100-00.		
<b>15. PRE RACE PADDOCK / WAITING ZONE:</b>		
The Pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone is situated	<b>Behind the starting gates</b>	
Before the scheduled start time of the first heat, competitors competing in the race concerned should move to the pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone.		



**16. STARTS:**

The Start of the race will be in accordance with SSR 230 – SSR 234 in the 2019 MSA National Motocross Regulations.  
 If a rider is not present in the pre-race paddock when he/she is called to the start line, he/she will forfeit his/her starting position.  
 Competitors who do not take part in official practice must confirm their intention to start to the COC, no less than one hour before the start of the first heat.  
 A change of vehicle will be permitted subject to valid reasons for the change being given and the jury of the meeting agreeing to the change. (Refer to GCR 259)

**17. END OF THE RACE:**

The waving of the chequered flag will signify the end of each race.  
 (Refer to SSR 237 – SSR 240 in the 2019 MSA National Motocross Regulations)  
 The MSA Steward/COC reserves the right to impound and examine any motorcycle at their discretion.

**18. NOTICE BOARD:**

The official notice board is situated at **The Zone 7 Clubhouse**

**19. RESULTS:**

Notwithstanding the general protest period laid down in the GCR's, the protest period for motocross will be 15 minutes from actual posting of the FINAL results on the notice board. (Refer to results GCR 276)  
 These results are not to be removed and disciplinary action will be taken against any person removing these results without authority. Additional copies may be obtained from the Secretary of the meeting.

**20. PRIZEGIVING:**

The prize giving will take place as soon as possible following the last heat and after the results become final.  
 Dead heats will be resolved as per GCR 275 and SSR 239.  
 Competitor's attention is drawn to GCR's 274, GCR 280 and GCR 281.  
 Any rider not attending prize giving will forfeit his/her prize unless suitable arrangements are made with the Race Secretary or Sponsors Representative

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the meeting or any part thereof. In the event of any of the above, the Competitor/Entrant has no right to claim against the Promoter/Organiser in respect of any loss or damage he/she may incur, other than that specified in GCR 244. The meeting will not be postponed, abandoned or cancelled without the consent of the Jury President in accordance with GCR 152.

**24. RIDING CONDUCT:**

### 30. CLOSURE OF CIRCUIT:

Organisers and Clubs must close circuits on Wednesday, at no later than 19h00, **Wednesday 23 JANUARY 2019 19H00**, the week prior to the event.

The responsibility for establishing if a circuit is open lies with the competitor.

### 32. MINIMUM NUMBER OF STARTERS:

A minimum number of 4 starters for Club Championship classes must take part. If less than 6 entries are received in any of the club classes, that particular class may be combined with another class and competitors must nominate which class they would like to be scored in for the year.

### 35. CLASSES AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

#### **MX 50cc Newbee Auto Clutch (Air or Water Cooled) Social**

Open to riders from the year of their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.

2 Stroke air & water cooled not exceeding 52cc.

Wheel size - not exceeding 10" (rear) and 12" (front).

This will not be a championship class but trophies will be awarded on the days' result & Competitors in this class will be moved up to the appropriate class if they are deemed to fast according to lap times by the Zone 7 SpeedSpot Committee.

#### **MX 50cc Pro Auto Clutch (Air or Water Cooled) Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.

2 Stroke air & water cooled not exceeding 52cc.

Wheel size - not exceeding 10" (rear) and 12" (front). Carburettor size – 19mm as per the *motorcycle* manufacturers specifications (*stock*).

#### **MX 65cc Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 7<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.

Clutch lever with gears not to exceed 65cc.

Wheel size - not exceeding 12" (Rear) and 14" (front).

#### **MX 85cc Junior Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 8<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.

Clutch lever with gears not exceeding 85cc.

Irrespective of wheel size

#### **MX Pro mini Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.

85cc 2 stroke and 150cc 4 stroke motorcycles.

Wheel size – Rear 14" and Front 17" or Rear 16" and Front 19"

**MX High School****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.  
Two stroke motorcycles not exceeding 126cc.  
Wheel size – Rear 19” and Front 21”

**MX 2****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
125cc -150cc 2 stroke & 250cc 4 stroke motorcycles.  
Wheel size – Rear 19” and Front 21”

**MX 1****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
125cc 2 stroke - 300cc 2 Stroke & 250cc 4 stroke - 450cc 4 stroke motorcycles.  
Wheel size – Rear 19” and Front 21”

**MX 3****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 30<sup>th</sup> birthday.  
Vets & Masters will be combined for the 2019 Championship.  
Motorcycles of unrestricted capacity.  
Wheel size - mixed sizes as per manufacturer.

**MX Ladies****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday and older will compete in the 85cc Jnr class or 150cc 4 stroke class.  
Open to riders from the year of their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday and older can compete on Motorcycles not exceeding 125cc 2 stroke.  
Open to riders from the year of their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday and older can compete on Motorcycles not exceeding 250cc 4 stroke.  
Wheel size - mixed sizes as per manufacturer.

**MX Support****Social**

Open to riders from the year of their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday - 125cc Two Strokes only.  
Open to riders from the year of their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday - 125cc and over.  
Please note that any competitor that has held any Regional or National MX licence in the last 5 years is not eligible to compete in this class.  
This will not be a championship class but trophies will be awarded on the days' result & Competitors in this class will be moved up to the appropriate class if they are deemed too fast according to lap times by the Zone 7 SpeedSpot Committee.

**Over 35 125cc****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 35<sup>th</sup> birthday - Two Strokes only, not exceeding 126cc.  
Wheel size – Rear 19” and Front 21”

**Quad MX (Zone 7 only)****Club**

Open to riders from the year of their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs. Engine capacity up to 240cc 2 stroke and 350cc 4 stroke.  
Open to riders from the year of their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday. Engine Capacity up to 350cc 2 stroke and 450cc 4 stroke.

Where classes are combined riders need to choose the class they would like to enter (a minimum of 4 per class to declare class championship; however, it is entitled to withhold such declaration from any competition, should circumstances warrant such action.)
